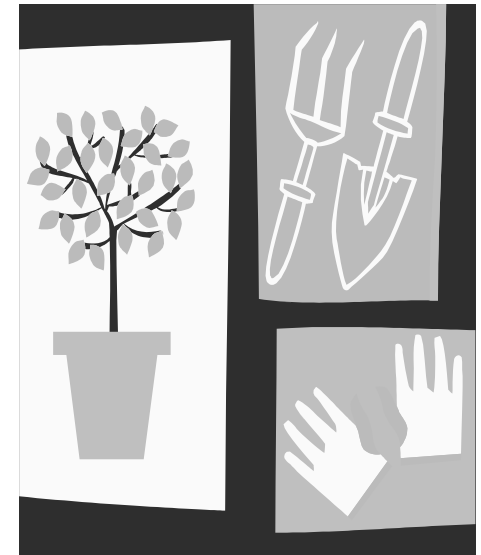
Directions to Prince George High School, 7801 Laurel Spring Road, Prince George, VA 23875:

From I-95: Take Wagner Road East, Exit 48-A. Continue on Wagner Road through intersection of Route 460 and Wagner Road (McDonalds on corner). Wagner Road becomes Courthouse Road at this intersection. Go 3.4 miles on Courthouse Road (bear right through roundabout) and turn right at next stoplight onto Laurel Spring Road/State Rte 616. Go 1.5 miles on Laurel Spring Road to Prince George High School on right.

I-295: Take Exit 38 to merge onto County Drive/US 460 West towards Petersburg. Go 0.8 miles and turn right onto Courthouse Road/VA 106 N. Go 3.4 miles on Courthouse Road (bear right through roundabout) and turn right at next stoplight onto Laurel Spring Road/State Rte 616. Go 1.5 miles on Laurel Spring Road to Prince George High School on right.
